Recycling Guidelines

Category:	
Aluminum Cans:	Empty and rinse cans. No food residue. Keep separate from tin. Crushing is optional but saves space
Antifreeze:	Cannot be mixed together with any other substance. Must be in a tightly sealed, labeled container not to exceed 5 gallons in size. For residents only.
Appliances:	Appliances such as refrigerators, chest freezers, air conditioners, accepted for recycling. Fees apply.
Batteries:	Lead acid and rechargeable batteries only. Alkaline batteries can be disposed of with your household trash.
Cell Phones	Cell phones and tablets are accepted free of charge. They should be dropped off at the Main Office.
Clear Glass:	Food and beverage bottles & jars only. Keep clear glass separate from colored. Remove lids and rings. Rinse well. No food residue. Labels can remain.
Clothing/Textiles:	Clean, gently used clothing, nylon curtains, drapes, towels, sheets, hats, belts, paired socks and shoes. Place in a heavy duty bag. Unable to accept wet/dirty clothing, rugs, or foam backed drapes.
Colored Glass:	Food and beverage bottles & jars only. Keep colored glass separate from clear. Remove lids and rings. Rinse well. No food residue. Labels can remain.
Corrugated Cardboard:	Flatten boxes & keep dry. Remove all plastic wrap and packing material such as Styrofoam, foam peanuts, air pillows, etc. No paperboard such as cereal/tissue boxes. No waxy or greasy cardboard.
Electronics:	Only accepting covered device electronics that are illegal to dispose of: TV's, computers, monitors, desktop printers, and computer peripherals. By appointment only, visit NTSWA.org. Fees apply.
Hard Cover Books	Hard cover books are accepted separately from mixed paper. Please see a worker for the designated location. They must be dry and clean and stacked in a box.
Household Hazardous Waste:	Special Collection event for households only. Visit www.NTSWA.org for information. For hazardous materials such as oil based paints/stains, mercury, fluorescent tubes, pool chemicals, pesticides, old gas, corrosives, etc.
Mixed Paper:	Includes junk mail, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, colored paper, shredded paper. Keep dry. Do not bundle, bag or tie.
Newspaper:	Newspaper only. Do not bundle or tie and keep dry. Keep separate from other types of paper. Inserts can remain.
Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Jars, Tubs:	Recycle only bottles, jugs, jars, and tubs. Includes water & soda bottles, laundry and milk jugs, shampoo bottles, yogurt container, butter tubs. Empty and rinse. No food residue. Lids can remain. Crush to save space. No black plastic, No flower pots, No clam shells, No plastic bags, No oil containers, No Styrofoam
Steel/"Tin" Cans:	Rinse and secure lids inside. No food residue. Keep separate from aluminum. Labels can remain.
Used Motor Oil:	Cannot be mixed together with any other substance. Must be in tightly sealed, labeled container not to exceed 5 gallons in size. For residents only.

ALL MATERIALS MUST BE SORTED BY CATEGORY AND LOOSE IN THE CONTAINER
