### Recycling Guidelines

<b>Category:</b>	<b>Check with the drop-off for potential holiday changes</b>
<b>Aluminum Cans:</b>	Empty and rinse cans. No food residue. Keep separate from tin. Crushing is optional but saves space
<b>Clear Glass:</b>	Food and beverage bottles & jars only. Keep clear glass separate from colored. Remove lids and rings. Rinse well. No food residue. Labels can remain.
<b>Colored Glass:</b>	Food and beverage bottles & jars only. Keep colored glass separate from clear. Remove lids and rings. Rinse well. No food residue. Labels can remain.
<b>Corrugated Cardboard:</b>	Flatten boxes & keep dry. Remove all plastic wrap and packing material such as Styrofoam, foam peanuts, air pillows, etc. No paperboard such as cereal/tissue boxes. No waxy or greasy cardboard.
<b>Mixed Paper:</b>	Includes junk mail, magazines, catalogs, newspaper, paperback books, colored paper, shredded paper. Keep dry. Do not bundle, bag or tie.
<b>Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Jars, Tubs:</b>	<b>Recycle only bottles, jugs, jars, and tubs.</b> Includes water & soda bottles, laundry and milk jugs, shampoo bottles, yogurt container, butter tubs. Empty and rinse. No food residue. Lids can remain. Crush to save space. <b>ABSOLUTELY NO CLAM SHELLS, BERRY, BAKERY, OR TAKEOUT CONTAINERS</b> <b>No black plastic, No flower pots, No hard/bulky plastic, No plastic bags, No oil containers, No Styrofoam</b>
<b>Steel/"Tin" Cans:</b>	Rinse and secure lids inside. No food residue. Keep separate from aluminum. Labels can remain.
